

## SCROLLS OF EZEKIEL UNVEILED

(Chronological Sequence — 1<sup>st</sup>  
scroll of 13)

**1st Scroll** — 5th year (592 B.C.)

### Word of Yahweh became known to Ezekiel

→ 5<sup>th</sup> day

(1:2) On the fifth of the month, (the fourth month), the fifth year of King Jehoiachin's captivity, (1:3) Coming the Word of Yahweh became known to Ezekiel, the son of Buzi, the priest in the land of the Chaldeans by the river Chebar. And the hand of Yahweh was on him there.

### Visions of God

(1:1) And it happened (\*when I was in my) thirtieth year, in the fourth month, in the fifth of the month. As I was among the captives by the river Chebar, the heavens were opened, and I saw visions of God. (1:4) And I looked, and behold, a windstorm came out of the north, a great cloud, and a fire flashing itself, and a brightness to it all around, and out of its midst, like the color of polished bronze out of the middle of the fire. \* Amplified Bible. Also see, 1:26

### Four Livings Creatures

(1:5) Also out of its midst *came* the likeness of four living creatures. **And this was how they looked;** they had the likeness of a man. (1:6) And four faces *were* to each, and four wings to each. (1:7) And their feet *were* straight feet; and the sole of their feet was like the sole of a calf's foot. And they sparkled like the color of burnished copper. (1:8) And the *hands* of a man *extended* from under their wings on their four sides; and the four of them *had* their faces and their wings, (1:9) joining each one to the other *by* their wings. They did not turn in their going; each one went toward the front of their face.

(1:10) **And the likeness of their faces:** the face of a man, and the face of a lion, on the right *side* to the four of them; and the face of an ox on the left side to the four of them; and the face of an eagle to the four of them. (1:11) **So their faces were.** And their wings *were* stretched upward; to each, the two *wings* of each one were joined;

and two *wings* covered their bodies. (1:12) And each went toward the front of their faces. To where the spirit was to go, there they went; they did not turn in their going.

(1:13) **And the likeness of the living creatures:** they looked like burning coals of fire; like the appearance of torches. It was continually circling among the living creatures. And the fire was bright, and out of the fire went forth lightning. (1:14) And the living creatures kept running and returning, like the appearance of a flash of lightning. (1:15) And as I looked at the living creatures, behold, one wheel was on the earth by the living creatures, with its four faces.

(1:16) **The appearance of the wheels and their workmanship** was the color of beryl, and the four of them had one likeness. And their appearance and their workmanship **was like a wheel in the middle of a wheel.** (1:17) When they went, they went on their four sides; *and* they did not turn when they went. (1:18) **And their rims:** they *were* even high; they *were* even awesome. And their rims *were* full of eyes all around the four of them. (1:19) And in the going of the living creatures, the wheels went beside them; and in the lifting up of the living creatures from the earth, the wheels were lifted up.

(1:20) Wherever the spirit was to go, there they went; **there the spirit was to go,** and the wheels were lifted up along with them. **For the spirit of the living creature was in the wheels.** (1:21) In their going, *these* went; and in their standing still, *these* stood still. And in their lifting up from the earth, the wheels were lifted up along with them. **For the spirit of the living creature was in the wheels.** ←

(1:22) **And there was a likeness over the heads of the living creature;** an expanse, like the color of awesome crystal stretched out over their heads from above. (1:23) And under the expanse their wings *were* straight, the one toward the other. Each one had two *wings* covering on this *side,* and to each two covering on that *side* of their bodies. (1:24) And I heard the sound of their wings, like the sound of great waters, like the

voice of the Almighty, in their going was the sound of tumult, like the sound of an army. In their standing still, they let down their wings. (1:25) **And there was a voice from the expanse, which was over their heads,** in their standing still, and they let down their wings.

### Glory of Yahweh upon His Throne

(1:26) And from above the expanse that was over their heads **was a likeness like a sapphire stone, the likeness of a throne. And on the likeness of the throne was a likeness looking like a man on it from above.** (1:27) **And I saw Him looking like the color of polished bronze, looking like fire all around within it. From the likeness of His loins even upward, and from the likeness of His loins even downward, I saw Him, looking like fire, and it had brightness all around.** (1:28) **As the bow (rainbow) that is in the cloud in the day of rain looks, so the brightness all around looked. This was how the likeness of the glory of Yahweh looked. And I saw. And I fell on my face, and I heard a voice of One speaking.** (2:1) And He said to me, Son of man, stand on your feet, and I will speak to you. (2:2) And the Spirit entered into me when He spoke to me, and set me on my feet, so that I heard Him who spoke to me.

### Ezekiel called to the rebellious House

(2:3) And He said to me, Son of man, **I am sending you to the sons of Israel, to the nations, the rebelling ones who have rebelled against Me;** they and their fathers have sinned against Me, to this day. (2:4) And the sons are stiff of face, and hard of heart. I am sending you to them; and you shall say to them, So says the Lord Yahweh. And they, whether they will hear or whether they will forbear; for they are a **rebellious house.** Yea, they shall know that there has been a prophet among them. (2:6) And you, son of man, do not be afraid of them, and of their words, though briers and thorns are with you, and you dwell among scorpions. Do not be afraid of their words, nor frightened by their faces, though they are a rebellious house. (2:7) And you shall speak My Words to them,

whether they will hear or whether they will forbear, for they are rebellious.

### Ezekiel instructed to eat the Scroll

(2:8) **But you, son of man, hear what I am saying to you.** Do not be rebellious like that rebellious house. Open your mouth and eat what I am giving you. (2:9) And I looked, and behold! A hand was extended to me; and lo, a roll of a book was in it. (2:10) And He spread it before me; **and it was written on the face and the back.** And written on it were weepings, and mourning, and woe. (3:1) And He said to me, Son of man, eat what you find. Eat this roll, and **go speak to the house of Israel.** (Tel-abib) (3:2) So I opened my mouth, and He caused me to eat that roll. (3:3) And He said to me, Son of man, cause your belly to eat, and fill your belly with this roll that I give you. Then I ate it; and in my mouth it was like honey for sweetness.

(3:4) And He said to me, Son of man, go! Go up to the **house of Israel** and speak to them with My Words. (3:5) For you are not sent to a people of a deep lip and of a difficult language, **but to the house of Israel;** (3:6) not to many people of a deep lip and of a difficult language, whose words you cannot hear. Surely, if I had sent you to them, they would have listened to you. (3:7) But the **house of Israel** will not listen to you, for they will not listen to Me; for all the **house of Israel** are strong of forehead and hard of heart. (3:8) Behold, I have made your face strong against their faces and your forehead strong against their foreheads. (3:9) I have made your forehead as adamant harder than flint. Do not be bowed down by their faces, though they are a **rebellious house.** (3:10) And He said to me, Son of man, receive all My Words, which I shall speak to you in your heart, and hear with your ears. (3:11) **And go! Go to those of the captivity,** to the sons of your people, and speak to them, and tell them, so says the Lord Yahweh; whether they will hear or whether they will forbear

### Ezekiel taken by the Spirit to the Captives at Tel-abib

(3:12) **And the Spirit lifted me up,** and I heard behind me a sound of a great rushing, **saying,**

**Blessed be the glory of Yahweh from His place.** (3:13) I also heard the sound of the wings of the living creatures touching one another, and the sound of the wheels along with them, and a sound of a great rushing.

### Ezekiel struck dumb

→ **5<sup>th</sup> — 12<sup>th</sup> day**

(3:14) **So the Spirit lifted me up** and took me away, and I went in bitterness, in the heat of my spirit; but the hand of Yahweh was strong on me. (3:15) Then I came to the **exiles at Tel-at-abib,** who lived by the **river Chebar.** And I sat where they sat; **and I also dwelt seven days, being stricken dumb among them.**

### At the end of seven days Ezekiel appointed a Watchman over the House of Israel and told to give them a warning!

→ **13<sup>th</sup> day**

(3:16) **And it happened at the end of seven days, even it happened that the Word of Yahweh came to me, saying,** (3:17) Son of man, **I have made you a watchman to the house of Israel.** Therefore hear the Word of My mouth, **and give them warning from Me.** (3:18) When I say to the wicked, You shall surely die; and you do not give him warning, nor speak to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked one shall die in his iniquity; but I will require his blood at your hand. (3:19) Yet if you warn the wicked, and he does not turn from his wickedness nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but you have delivered your soul. (3:20) And when the righteous turns from his righteousness and commits iniquity, and when I lay a stumbling block before him, he shall die. Because you have not given him warning, he shall die in his sin, and his righteousness, which he has done, shall not be remembered; but his blood I will require at your hand. (3:21) But if you warn the righteous so that the righteous does not sin, and if he does not sin, he shall surely live because he is warned; also you have delivered your soul.

### Yahweh instructs Ezekiel to come out of his house and to meet Him on the plain

(3:22) **And the hand of Yahweh was on me there.** And He said to me, Arise, go out into the **plain,**

and I will talk with you there. (3:23) Then I arose and went out into the **plain;** and, behold, the glory of Yahweh stood there, **like the glory, which I saw by the river Chebar.** **And I fell on my face.** (3:24) And the Spirit entered into me and set me on my feet; and spoke with me, and said to me, **Go, shut yourself inside your house!**

### Ezekiel told that the captives would bind him in his house (Tel-abib). Ezekiel remained dumb for 7 ½ years

(3:25) But you, O son of man, behold, **they shall put bands on you and shall bind you with them,** and you shall not go out among them. (3:26) **And I will make your tongue cling to the roof of your mouth, so that you shall be dumb and shall not be one who warns them. For they are a rebellious house.** See, below and scroll eleven. Also, Ch24: 27 - 33:21. During this period he could only speak what Yahweh told him to say. Fulfilled 12<sup>th</sup> year, 10 months, 5<sup>th</sup> day.

### Ezekiel acts out via a model the siege of Jerusalem as a sign to the House of Israel

(3:27) **But when I speak with you, I will open your mouth,** and you shall say to them, So says the Lord Yahweh: He who hears, let him hear; and he who stops his ears, let him stop; for they are a **rebellious house.** (4:1) **And you, son of man, take a tile to yourself, and lay it before you, and portray on it the city Jerusalem.** (4:2) **And lay siege against it, and build a fort against it, and cast a mound against it, and set battering rams against it all around.** (4:3) And take an iron griddle to yourself, and set it for a wall of iron between you and the city. And set your face against it, and it shall be under attack. And you shall set a battle against it. **This shall be a sign to the house of Israel.** See, Ch 5:1-4

### Bear the iniquities of the House of Israel and the House of Judah

(4:4) Also lie on your left side, and lay the iniquity of the **house of Israel** on it; according to the number of days that you shall lie on it, you shall bear their iniquity. (4:5) **For I have laid on you the**

years of their iniquity, according to the number of the days, three hundred and ninety days. So you shall bear the iniquity of the **house of Israel**. (4:6) And when you have fulfilled them, lie again on your right side, **and you shall bear the iniquity of the house of Judah forty days; a day for a year; a day for a year**, I have set for you. (4:7) **And you shall set your face toward the siege of Jerusalem**, and your arm shall be uncovered, and you shall prophesy against it. (4:8) **And, behold, I will lay bands on you, and you shall not turn yourself from one side to another until you have ended the days of your siege. 430 days (390 + 40) concluded on 23<sup>rd</sup> day, 8<sup>th</sup> month, 6<sup>th</sup> year**

**During the 390 days Ezekiel to only eats and drinks food prepared from the recipe which Abba gave him**

(4:9) Take also to yourself wheat, and barley, and beans, and lentils, and millet, and spelt, and put them in one vessel, and make bread of them for yourself. According to the number of the days that you shall lie on your side, three hundred and ninety days, you shall eat of it. (4:10) And your food, which you shall eat, *shall be* by weight twenty shekels a day; from time to time you shall eat it. (4:11) You shall also drink water by measure, the sixth part of a hin. **From time to time you shall drink.** (4:12) **And you shall eat it as barley cakes**, and you shall bake it with dung of the excrement of man, in their sight. (4:13) And Yahweh said, Even so shall the **sons of Israel** eat their defiled bread among the nations, where I will drive them.

(4:14) Then I said, Ah Lord Yahweh! Behold, my soul has not been defiled. For from my youth up, even till now, I have not eaten of that which dies of itself, or is torn in pieces; neither did there come any unclean flesh into my mouth. (4:15) Then He said to me, Lo, I have given you cow's dung for man's dung, and you shall prepare your bread with it. (4:16) And He said to me, Son of man, behold, I will break the staff of bread in Jerusalem. And they shall eat bread by weight, and with care. **And they shall drink water by measure, and in silence**, (4:17) **so that they may lack bread and**

**water, and be stricken dumb with one another, and waste away in their iniquity.**

**At the end of the 430 days, prophetically demonstrate via a model the famine that will come upon Jerusalem**

(5:1) And you, son of man, take a sharp sword to yourself, take a barber's razor also, and cause it to pass on your head and on your beard. **Then take scales to weigh, and divide the hair.** See, Ch 3:27, Ch 4:1-3, Ch 12:1-7. **430 day's end: 22<sup>nd</sup> day, 6<sup>th</sup> month, 6<sup>th</sup> year.** ←

(5:2) You shall burn a **third part** with fire in the **middle of the city, when the days of the siege are fulfilled**; and you shall take a **third part** and beat around it with a sword; and you shall scatter a third part in the wind, and I will draw out a sword after them. (5:3) Also you shall take **a few of them in number, and tie them up in your skirts.** (5:4) Then take of them again, and throw them into the middle of the fire, and burn them in the fire; **for a fire shall come forth from them into all the house of Israel.**

**Yahweh's Indictment!**

→ 13<sup>th</sup> day

(5:5) So says the Lord Yahweh: **This is Jerusalem.** I have set it in the middle of the nations, and all around her *are* the lands. (5:6) And she has changed My judgments into wickedness more than the nations, and *defiled* My Laws more than the countries that *are* all around her; for they have rejected My judgments and My Laws; they have not walked in them. (5:7) Therefore so says the Lord Yahweh: Because you multiplied more than the nations that *are* all around you, and have not walked in My Laws, neither have kept My judgments, nor have done according to the judgments of the nations all around you; (5:8) therefore so says the Lord Yahweh; Behold, I, even I, *am* against you, and will carry out judgments in your midst before the nations.

(5:9) And I will do in you that which I have not done, and the like of which I will never do again, because of all your abominations. (5:10) **So the fathers shall eat**

**the sons in your midst, and the sons shall eat their fathers.** And I will execute judgments in you, and I will scatter the whole remnant of you into all the winds. (5:11) **Therefore, as I live, says the Lord Yahweh, surely, because you have defiled My sanctuary with all your detestable things, and with all your abominations, therefore I will also withdraw; nor shall My eye spare you, nor will I have any pity. A third part of you shall die with the plague, and shall be consumed with the famine in your midst. And a third part shall fall by the sword all around you; and I will scatter a third part into all the winds, and I will draw out a sword after them.** (5:13) So My anger shall be fulfilled, and I will cause My fury to rest on them, and I will be comforted. And they shall know that I Yahweh have spoken it in My zeal, when I have fulfilled My fury in them.

(5:14) **And I will make you a waste and a curse among the nations that are all around you**, in the sight of all who pass by. (5:15) So it shall be a reproach and a taunt, a chastening and a horror to the nations, which are all around you, when I shall execute judgments against you in anger and in fury and in rebukes among them. I Yahweh have spoken it. (5:16) When I shall send on them the evil arrows of famine, which shall be for *their* ruin, which I will send to destroy you; even I will increase the famine on you, and break your staff of bread;

(5:17) yea, I will send on you famine and evil beasts, and you will be bereaved. And pestilence and blood shall pass among you; and I shall bring a sword on you. **I Yahweh have spoken.**

**Prophecy against the Mountains of Israel**

(6:1) **And it happened, the Word of Yahweh came to me, saying,** (6:2) Son of man, set your face toward the mountains of Israel and prophesy against them. (6:3) And say, Mountains of Israel, hear the Word of the Lord. **So says the Lord Yahweh** to the mountains, and to the hills, to the rivers and to the valleys: Behold, I, even I, will bring a sword on you, and I will destroy your high places. (6:4) And

your altars shall be wasted, and your pillars shall be broken. And I will make fall your slain before your idols. (6:5) And I will put the dead bodies of the **sons of Israel** before their idols; and I will scatter your bones around your altars. (6:6) In all the places where you live, cities shall be laid waste, and the high places shall be deserted; so that your altars may be laid waste and become guilty, and your idols may be broken and cease, and your pillars may be cut down, and your works wiped out. (6:7) And the slain shall fall in the midst of you, **and you shall know that I am Yahweh.**

(6:8) **Yet I will leave a remainder that may be left to you** some who escape the sword among the nations, when you are scattered through the lands. (6:9) And those of you who escape shall remember Me among the nations where they shall be exiled, because I was broken by their whoring heart which has departed from Me, and with their whoring eyes which go after their idols. And they shall despise themselves for the evils, which they have committed in all their abominations. (6:10) And they shall know that I am Yahweh, **and that I have not said in vain to do this evil to them.**

(6:11) So says the Lord Yahweh: Strike with your hand and stamp with your foot, and say, Alas, for all the evil abominations of the **house of Israel!** **For they shall fall by the sword, and by the famine, and by the plague.** (6:12) He who is afar off shall die of the plague; and he who is near shall fall by the sword; **and he who remains and is under siege shall die by the famine.** So I will fulfill My fury on them. (6:13) Then you shall know that I am Yahweh, when their dead shall be among their idols all around their altars, on every high hill, in all the tops of the mountains, and under every green tree, and under every leafy oak, the place where they offered sweet aroma to all their idols. (6:14) And I will stretch out My hand on them and make the land a waste, even more desolate than the wilderness toward Diblath, in all the places where they live; **and they shall know that I am Yahweh.**

### Prophecy that the end has come for the land of Israel

(7:1) **And it happened, the Word of Yahweh came to me, saying,** (7:2) And you, son of man, so says the Lord Yahweh to the land of Israel: An end! **The end has come on the four corners of the land.** (7:3) Now the end is on you, and I will send My anger on you and will judge you according to your ways, and will lay on you all your abominations. (7:4) And My eye shall not spare you, neither will I have pity. But I will repay your ways on you, and your abominations shall be in your midst; **and you shall know that I am Yahweh.**

(7:5) **So says the Lord Yahweh:** An evil: Behold, an only evil has come! (7:6) An end has come, the end has come. It awakes against you; behold, it has come. (7:7) The encirclement has come to you, O dwellers of the land. The time has come, the day of tumult is near, and not a shout of the mountains. (7:8) And I will soon pour out My fury on you, and fulfill My anger on you. And I will judge you according to your ways, and will repay you for all your abominations. (7:9) And My eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity; I will repay you according to your ways and your abominations *that are in your midst.* And you shall know that I am Yahweh who strikes.

(7:10) Behold the day! Behold, it has come; the encirclement has gone out; the rod has blossomed; pride has budded. (7:11) Violence has risen up for a rod of wickedness. None of them *shall remain*, nor of their multitude, nor of any of their riches; nor *shall there be* wailing for them. (7:12) The time has come; the day has arrived. Let not the buyer rejoice, nor the seller mourn; for wrath is on all her multitude. (7:13) For the seller shall not return to that which is sold, although they are still alive; for the vision to all her multitude shall not return, and a man shall not hold his life strong in iniquity. (7:14) **They have blown the trumpet, even to make all ready; but none goes to the battle,** for My wrath is on all her multitude. (7:15) The sword is outside, and the plague and the famine inside. He who is in the field shall die with the sword; and he in the city shall be devoured by famine and

plague. (7:16) But *if* their fugitives shall escape, then they shall be like doves of the valleys on the mountains, all of them mourning, each one for his iniquity. (7:17) All hands shall be feeble, and all knees shall go *weak as water.* (7:18) They shall also gird on sackcloth, and trembling shall cover them; and shame *shall be* on all faces, and baldness on all heads. (7:19) **They shall throw their silver in the streets, and their gold shall be an impure thing. Their silver and their gold shall not be able to deliver them in the day of the wrath of Yahweh.**

They shall not satisfy their souls, neither fill their bowels; because their iniquity has become a stumbling-block for them. (7:20) And the beauty of His ornament, He set it in majesty. But they made the images of their abominations *and* of their hateful things in it; therefore I have put it to them as an impure thing. (7:21) And I will give it into the hands of the strangers for a prize, and to the wicked of the earth for a spoil; and they shall defile it. (7:22) I will also turn My face from them, and they shall defile My secret *place*; and violent ones shall enter into it and defile it. (7:23) Make a chain; for the land is full of bloody judgments, and the city is full of violence. (7:24) And I will bring the most evil of the nations, and they shall possess their houses. I will also make the pomp of the strong to cease; and their holy places shall be defiled. (7:25) Ruin comes; and they shall seek peace, but none *shall be.* Disaster on disaster shall come, and rumor to rumor shall be. And they shall seek a vision from the prophet; but the law shall perish from the priest, and wisdom from the elders. (7:27) The king shall mourn, and the prince shall be clothed with despair, and the hands of the people of the land shall be troubled. I will do to them according to their way, and according to their judgments I will judge them; **and they shall know that I am Yahweh**
