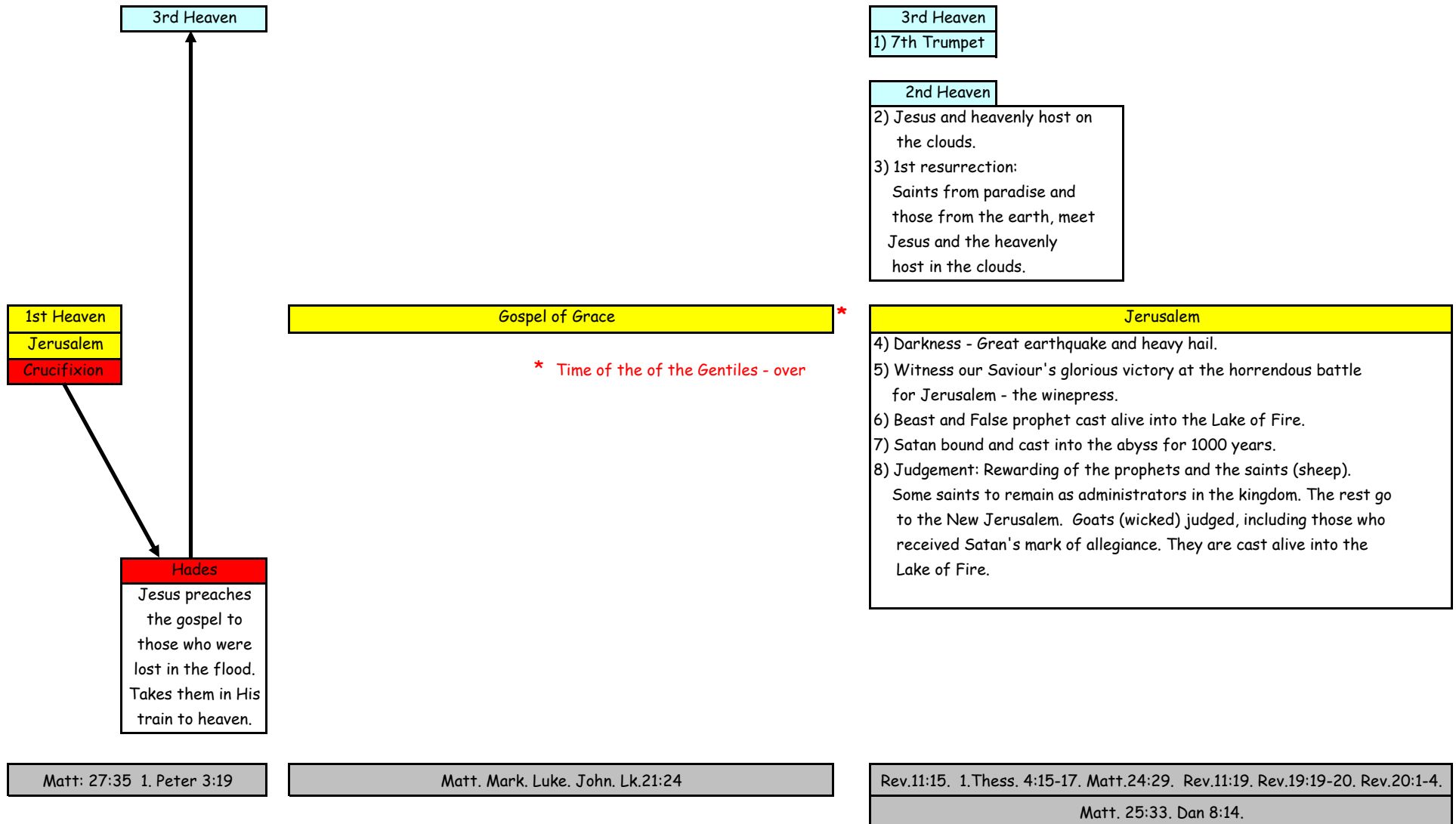


SequenceLine: Crucifixion to the New Jerusalem

Jerusalem

- 1) After the 1000 years, Satan is loosed. Within a relatively short period he is able to sow seeds of rebellion - culminating in the battle of Gog and Magog for Jerusalem.

- 5) Hades is cast into the Lake of Fire - signifying the total banishment of the abode of evil and rebellion (Rev. 20:14).
- 6) Jesus and the millennial inhabitants translated to the New Jerusalem.
- 7) The present earth is totally destroyed by fire and becomes void.
