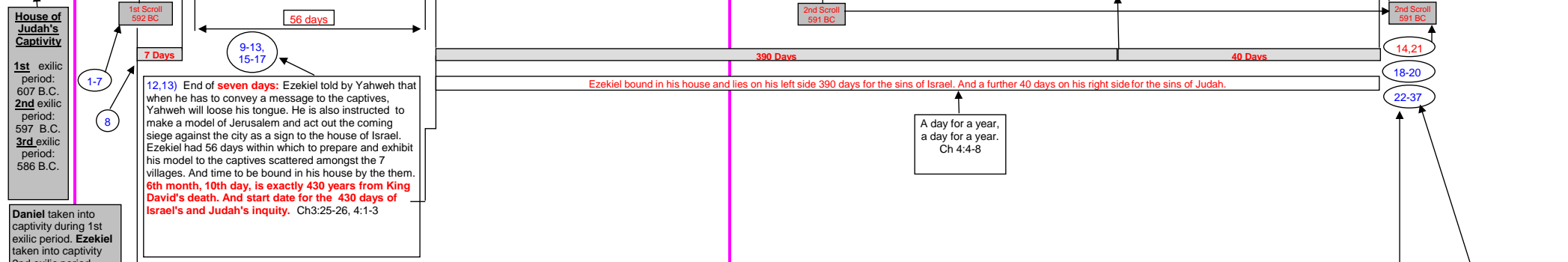

**House of Judah's Captivity**  
 1st exilic period: 607 B.C.  
 2nd exilic period: 597 B.C.  
 3rd exilic period: 586 B.C.

**Daniel** taken into captivity during 1st exilic period. **Ezekiel** taken into captivity 2nd exilic period. **Jeremiah** remained in Judea (627 - 574). **Temple destroyed:** 586 B.C. **Basic Restoration:** 536 B.C. - 520 B.C. **Completed:** 516 B.C. and dedicated 515 B.C. = 70 years as prophesied: **Dan 9:2** In the first year of his reign, I, Daniel, understood the number of the years by books, which came of the Word of Yahweh to Jeremiah the prophet, that he would accomplish **seventy years** in the desolations of Jerusalem. **Jer 29:10** For so says Yahweh, When according to My Word **seventy years** have been fulfilled for Babylon, I will visit you and confirm My good Word to you, to bring you back to this place. **Thus: Seventy years** from the destruction of the Temple in **586 B.C.** to the partial completion date in **516 B.C.** dedicated: 515 B.C.

- Word of Yahweh Became Known to Ezekiel whilst he was with captives at another location on the banks of the river Chebar
  - Visions of God

- At the end of seven days Ezekiel appointed a Watchman over the House of Israel and told to give them a warning

  - Ezekiel told that the captives would bind him in his house. **(Ezekiel remained dumb for 7 1/2 years)**
  - Ezekiel instructed by Yahweh to make a model of Jerusalem and act out via his model the coming siege of Jerusalem as a sign to the House of Israel (this he does before he is bound).
  - Bear the iniquities of the House of Israel and the House of Judah 430 days, a day for a year... (Eze 4:6). During the 430 days Ezekiel only eats and drinks food prepared from the recipe which Abba gave him
  - At the end of the 430 days, prophetically demonstrate via a model the famine that will come upon Jerusalem Ch3:25,26. 4:1-3
- 15) **Yahweh's Indictment!**
- Prophecy against the Mountains of Israel
  - Prophecy that the end has come for the land of Israel

 (N.B. Ezekiel's 430 days ended on the 10th of the 11th month)
- Ezekiel sitting in his house (no longer bound) with the Elders of Judah sitting before him

After the Spirit returns Ezekiel to captives at Tel-Abib on the 12th day he demonstrates via his model of Jerusalem the horrendous siege conditions that will prevail there in the future. He also demonstrates exile for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, this came to pass 586 B.C. Ch 12:1 - 7. He had to repeat the same demonstrations to the other captive villages on the Chebar River. He also Prophecied captivity for King Zedekiah (still in Jerusalem at the time) and how he and his entourage would try and avoid capture - but to no avail. Prophecy fulfilled 5 years later ( see 7th scroll). **Ezekiel a sign to the house of Israel** Ch 12:8 - 16.

Jesus shows Ezekiel a completely New Temple (design) that must be built by the returnees. One which He would have occupied had they received Him as Messiah. (April 6th, A.D. 32).

**Temple Info:**  
Wilderness = Tabernacle. Promised Land = 1st Temple (King Solomon). Temple destroyed 586 B.C. 2 nd Temple rebuilt on existing site (Ezra 5:15b). Completed 516 B.C. and dedecated 515 B.C. **Temple as per Ezekiel 40 has none of the following:**

- \* High Priest - Zech 6:12-13, Jeremiah 23:5-6
- \* Veil
- \* Altar of Incense
- \* Table of Show Bread
- \* Pot of Manna
- \* Shew Bread

**NOTES:** Cyrus captured Babylon in 539 B.C. The last recorded message of Ezekiel is 570 B.C. Cyrus allowed the Jews to return to Israel. Their return may have taken place in the year 537 B.C. onward. It is also possible that Ezekiel died some time after 570 B.C. as there were no more recorded messages after this date. If he did return to Jerusalem he is not mentioned again. Which in itself is very odd, as one would have expected someone of his stature to have been spoken of. Josephus says on page 228 that the first year of Cyrus - was the 70th year that his people (house of Judah) were removed from their land. This would have been around 607 B.C. Therefore, if we subtract 70 years from 607 we come to 537 B.C. So, it is probable that the captive began to make there way back to Jerusalem some time around 537 B.C. Isaiah 44:28

**RELIABLE DATES**

There appears to be only two reliable dates regarding the chronology of Ezekiel. They are as follows:

- 1) 586 B.C. When the Temple was destroyed - signifying the beginning of Jerusalem's 70 years of desolation. Which ended in 516 B.C. when the temple was completed and then dedicated 515 B.C.
- 2) 572 B.C. Wherin it is stated: "14 years after the city was stricken." Ch 40:1
